Riders must have participated in one of the barrel competitions listed in the competition location section. On each weekend, riders can qualify for the right to enter St-Tite (depending on the results of the competitions). If a rider is already qualified in the 1st positions of the go, we take the following positions. The rider can present a single mount at St-Tite. When the rider is qualified, we go directly to the next position. During registration, the rider can register with the mount of his choice. If the rider is injured, we move on to the next person.
